The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) Solid Waste Branch (SWB) received a permit renewal application from Hardin County Fiscal Court to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 047-00040 for Hardin County Contained Landfill in Hardin County to November 9, 2035.

The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
